What is the CAASPP?

The California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) consists of assessments aligned with the state standards that outline the expectations for what students know and can do. Students in grades three through eight and eleven take the English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics assessments. Students take the California Science Test (CAST) in grades five and eight, and once in high school. With each assessment, students are expected to write clearly, think critically, and solve problems.

If you have any questions about the assessments or your child's results, you may contact your child's teacher for more information.

What do the scores mean?

Students receive an overall score and an achievement level. There are four different achievement levels that describe students' grade-level knowledge and skills:

	Level 4: Advanced
	Level 3: Proficient
	Level 2: Developing
	Level 1: Minimal

In addition, there is more detailed information about student performance in specific areas, which is reported as one of three categories:

-  Above Proficient
-  At or Near Proficient
-  Below Proficient

These results provide a measure of where students are in the development of their knowledge and skills. Assessment results are only one measure and should be combined with other information to better understand student achievement.

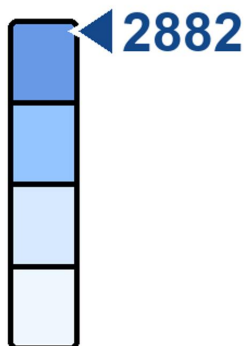

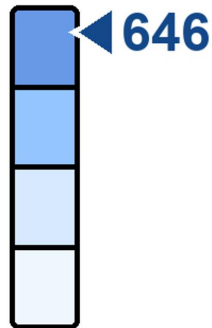
